my doctor bills and funeral expenses, be paid,

2nd. It is my will and desire that Henrietta Wyall shall have during
her natural life the use of my dwelling house, with the other houses, in the
same side of the lane, and the land on which it is situated, from the mining
branch to the first ditch above the house, bounded by the lane and the
aforesaid ditch, with the privilege of wood and rail timber.

3rd. It is my will and desire after all my just debts are paid, that
my brother John Jones, and my sister Amanda Leathers shall have one
dollar to them and their heirs forever,

4th. It is my will and desire that Henrietta Wyall shall have all
other expenses are paid) have out of my estate, two hundred pounds of pork
and four barrels of corn for her next years provisions,

5. It is my will and desire, that Wiley Jones, son of my nephew
John Jones, now living in Petersburg Va shall have all my land including
also the land willed to Henrietta Wyall as aforesaid, the whole excepting
that willed to Henrietta Wyall, shall be his at my death, that willed to
Henrietta Wyall shall be his at her death, also all my other estate including
chattel and all I possess, after all debts are paid shall be his, and his heirs,
or if he has other brothers, between them all,

6. It is my will and desire lastly, that I
