I, Wm. Henry Copeland, of Nansemond County, Virginia, hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time made, do hereby make my last will and testament as follows:  
1st. I direct that my just debts shall be paid.

2nd. I direct that all my house-hold & kitchen furniture & all chattel estate be sold to the highest bidder for cash, and equally divided among my heirs (except Jm's Eley Copeland, who has been given his part of my estate, namely, 12 acres of land) John H. Copeland, Lemmie Copeland, Sarah E. Copeland, Ester Copeland and Martha Ann (Copeland) Jones.

3rd. I give and bequeath to my daughter, Martha Ann (Copeland) Jones, all my land, bounded as follows: Bounded by Caroline Langston, The Morffith land, the Creek Bridge & the Franklin road & containing fifty-two acres of land.

4th. I name and appoint my daughter, Martha Ann (Copeland) Jones, my executrix of this my will and request that she be allowed to qualify and give bond without security.
