State of Virginia do make and publish this my last
will and testament, hereby revoking and making
void all former wills by me at any time heretofore
made and first I direct that my Body be decently
interred and that my funeral be conducted in a
manner corresponding with my estate and situation
in life; and as to such worldly estate as is hath
pleased God to intrust me with I dispose of the same
as follows

1st I direct that all my debts and funeral expenses to
with funeral charges be paid as soon after my decease as possible out of the
back, mentioned first money that shall come into the hands of my
executors as this.

2nd By bequest from my portion of my Estate real or personal
After my death I give to William T Compp the Grant
of Land on which he at this time resides and known
by the name of Kinnighams.

3rd I Give to Lucy Woodward a house and lot of Land
lying and being in the County of Henrico and more
particularly described by deed of record in the
Clerk's office of Henrico County and purchased by
me from Bernhard Brice and Sarah his wife

and also one other lot of land adjoining the first named lot and House purchased of the same parties and after her death I direct that the said lot and House and all other property she may receive from my estate be equally divided between the lawful issue of her Body 4th I give to ~~Phos~~ Alphens, H. Garnett all the Land which I have fee simple right to adjoining the tract of Land on which I at this reside and all other Land that I may purchase adjoining the same.

5th I direct that the sum of three hundred dollars be received by E. C. Gifford in the hands of my Executor and used as they ~~may~~ think will ~~four~~ ^{best} bear for the benefit of Elly & Garnett and her children. 6th I wish all of my estate of every description now heretofore in me as this disposed of to be equally divided between Wm & Leonard Gacey, A. Woodward, and Alphens, H. Garnett as heretofore directed that is to say upon loan to Gacey, A. Woodward, and lastly I appoint my friend Nathl G. Savage and my nephew Alphens H. Garnett Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
