this my last will and Testament, to wit: I give and devise
unto Ann Eliza Parkinson and Mariah Louisa Johnson
(children of my son Verdon D. Christian) in fee simple one
equal half ~~part~~ of my land lying and being in the State
of Kentucky. I give and devise unto the children of my
son Archer D. Christian the remaining half part of my land

lying and being in The State of Kentucky to them in fee
simple. I give and bequeath ~~unto~~ ^{to} my daughter Caroline M
Christian in absolute property, one bed and furniture and
one bureau at Steamore Springs one Rocking chair one
mattress, one trunk and contents and one sleeping bag at
Belle Isle - I give to Ann Eliza Parkinson my couch and
furniture in absolute property. It is my wish and desire
that my children and grand children should not be
required to pay any amount in which they may be indebted
to me - I give to my Grandson Samuel P. Christian all the
residue of my estate to him and his heirs forever - I nominate
and appoint my said Grandson Samuel P. Christian Executor
of this my last will and I desire that he may - allowed to
qualify without giving security - I do not wish that any
inventory or appraisement of my estate may be taken -
