1st I bequeath unto Nephew John Brown Lister the sum of two hundred dollars the sum to carry interest at six per cent from March 31st 1871 till he hundred and fifty six till my Executor hereafter named shall settle up my estate; but in the event that my Nephew John Brown Lister should die before he arrived at the age of twenty one years, and my brother Benj F Lister should survive him, then I leave the same to my said brother Benj F Lister during his lifetime after which I wish the same to be equally divided among the children hereafter named (William Franklin Martin excepted)

2nd I give unto my brother Benj F Lister the sum of twenty dollars.

3rd I give unto my little friend William Franklin Martin the sum of ten dollars and 4th whatever may be due me on bonds &c after the above bequests shall have been settled or paid off, I wish the same to be divided equally among the following relations of mine, viz: William Joseph Woodward, Virginia Franklin Woodward, Mary Frances Sweeney, Joseph Woodward Sweeney, Maria Louisa Sweeney, Minny Sweeney and the children of my niece, Eliza A Atkinson and the eldest son of Martin I'm mighty now a resident of the County of Henrico 5th and lastly I appoint my son Benj F Lister executor of this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills and testaments heretofore made by me In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of March 1880.

2nd I gave unto my brother, Benj. F. Lester the sum of twenty dollars.
3rd I gave unto my little friend William Franklin Mathew the sum
of ten dollars and 4th whatever may be due me on bonds or other
debt the above bequests shall have been settled or paid off. I wish the same
to be divided equally among the following relations of mine, viz: Wil-
liam Joseph Woodward, Eugenia Franklin Woodward, Mary Frances
Sweeney, Joseph Woodward Sweeney, Maria Louisa Sweeney, Henry Swee-
ney and the children of my niece, Eliza R. Atkinson and the
eldest son of Mathew I meanly now a resident of the County of Henrico.
5th and lastly I appoint my Bro. Benj. F. Lester executor of this my
last will and testament, revoking all former wills and testaments
heretofore made by me. In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand
and affix my seal, this the 28th day of May, one thousand eight
hundred and fifty nine.
