I, Henry B. Sherman, of New Kent Co., Va., being of sound mind and in good health, do make this my last will and testament as follows: I give all of my

property including lands, mill teams, farming utensils, furniture and everything else I own to Edmund Saunders of Charles City County, Virginia. I also give him all my papers and papers in hand and due me from any and every person whatever. I also give him my gold watch which is now in the possession of Mrs Martin Baker of Henrico County. Va. I desire Edmund Saunders to give the watch to his son Edmund when he gets to be only one year old. I also give the said Edmund Saunders, Sen. all of my negroes and everything else I own, or that may fall to me in the future. If I have neglected to mention anything that belongs to me to my intention to give whatever I have forgotten to him the said Edmund Saunders, Sr. I hereby desire the said Edmund Saunders to have a hand-some tombstone erected over my body, after he has settled up my estate and paid all my just debts. I leave Edmund Saunders to act as my Executor and Administrator. This was written and signed by myself at Chaffins Bluff, in the County of Henrico, Va, on the 4th day of October, 1864.

Saunders came into court and taking the oath of an executor and entering into and acknowledging a bond payable to the Commonwealth in the penalty of seven thousand dollars conditioned according to law with Elijah Ball and Henry D. Varden as his securities who justified as to their sufficiency, certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of said will in due form.
