

In the name of God Amen. I John J Harris of the
 County of New Kent State of Virginia being of sound
 mind and disposing memory do make and constitute
 this my last will and testament hereby revoking all
 other wills heretofore by me made. Item 1st I direct
 that all of my just debts be first paid out of my estate.
 Item 2nd I leave to my dear wife Caroline Harris
 the farm on which I reside known as Callamell
 containing four hundred acres land more or less during
 her life and at her death said farm shall be sold
 and the proceeds equally divided between my children
 except to Edward. I also leave to my wife to be
 Harris all the money which may be obtained on my
 life insurance policy in the New York Insurance Company
 of Hartford State of Connecticut and at her death
 to be divided as above. Item 3rd I give to my dear
 wife Caroline all crops on hand and growing and
 the above mentioned farm, all household and other
 furniture all stock of every kind and disceptation
 and all farming utensils and seed farms in fee.
 Item 4th all other real estate of which I shall
 be possessed shall be sold and all other money
 due me from other sources collected and equally
 divided between my children except to Edward
 who will be provided for in another Item. Item 5th
 I give to my dear wife Caroline to be paid and

and my former other assets collected and equally
divided between my children except Caroline Howard
who will be provided for in another item. Item 3rd
The bond which I hold against Geo W Howard and
to be Howard's his wife I give in trust to John W Harris
for the benefit of Caroline to Howard and her children
Item 6th I appoint and constitute my dear wife Caroline
to Harris my lawful Executor to this my last will
without reserve requesting my sons John W & 4 and
B W Harris to act as advisors and
Went under my hand and seal this 20th May 1886

In New Kent County Court January 13th 1887

A writing purporting to be the last will and Testament
of John W Harris deceased was this day produced in
this Court and there being no subscribing witnesses
present. Geo W Harris and R D Day were sworn and
sovereignly deposed that they are well acquainted with
the testator's hand writing and verily believe the said
writing and the name thereto subscribed to be wholly
written by the testator's own hand whereupon the
said writing is ordered as the ^{only} last will and
Testament of John W Harris deceased.
