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January 13th 1865-

In the name of God I Fredrick Croasin of the County of New Kent and State of Virginia now being of sound mind and judgment, do make this my last, will and Testament this 13th of January, eighteen hundred & sixty five,

I wish and desire after my decease, that Mr. Mason, qualify as my executor, as my representative and sell all the property I leave at my decease, and pay all my just debts, and the balance I give to Francis Mason. Now the wife of Robert M. Mason, and the said Mr. Mason, is today all left, after paying my just debts to the said Francis Mason, the above is my wish will act and deed. Witness I set my hand & seal, this 13th of January, eighteen hundred & sixty five,
