in testimony of my love and affection for her all my estate
meysage ground land hereditaments and premises situate in
the County of New Kent which consists of land and tenements
with the appurtenances thereof together with all the fixturs all
buildings live and dead stock one Horse; Cattle, Horse hold
& Kitchen furniture, Crops of Corn & fodder & farming utensils
of all kinds belonging thereto to have and to hold the same
under her own control and management during her natural
life at the death of my wife Susan Williams I give and
bequeath unto my daughter Ellen, H. & later and to her child
and to the future heirs of her body all of the aforesaid property
both personal and real. Should my daughter Ellen, H. & later
die previous to her husband Dⁿ L. A. Slater leaving no children or
children then I desire my son in Law Dⁿ L. A. Slater to have all of
my estate both personal and real to have and to hold the same
forever to his own proper use and benefit. And I do hereby
nominate and appoint Dⁿ L. A. Slater to be Exor. of this my
last will and testament. And I hereby revoke and make
void all former wills or wills heretofore made by me or any

of kitchen furniture, Crocks of Corn & food & Hanning utensils
of all kinds belonging there to & to hold the same
under her own control and management during her natural
life as the death of my wife, Susan Williams I give and
bequeath unto my daughter Ellen, H. Slater and to her child
and to the future heirs of her body all of the aforesaid property
both personal and real. Should my daughter Ellen, H. Slater
die previous to her husband Dr. L. A. Slater bearing no children or
children then I desire my son in Law Dr. L. A. Slater to heir all of
my estate both personal and real to have and to hold the same
for ever to his own proper use and benefit. And I do hereby
nominate and appoint Dr. L. A. Slater to be Exor. of this my
last will and Testament. And I hereby revoke and make
void all former wills or will heretofore made by me at any
time or times. In Testimony whereof I the said testator
Leroy Williams have to this my last will and Testament set
my hand and seal this the 9th day of October in the year 1869
