 this my last will & testament in manner and form as
 follows. Item. It is my will & desire That my just debts and
 funeral expences be paid. Item - I leave to my daughter
 Mary & her husband Edmund Howle during their natural
 lives the Tract of land on which I now reside, with all
 the appurtenances thereto belonging & my little negro
 child Louiza & her future increase, and at the death
 of the said Edmund & Mary Howle, I give & bequeath
 in fee simple the above named tract of land & Negro
 child Louiza & her future increase to be equally divided
 between the children which my said daughter Mary may
 leave at her death; Item - I give and bequeath my negro
 woman Sylvia to Wm B Morecock & Thomas E. Davis in Trust
 for the benefit & use of my two daughters Nancy Wright and
 Martha Brins & it is my will & desire That my said Trustees
 Wm B. Morecock & Thomas E. Davis or either of them who may
 be good enough to accept the Trust aforesaid for the purpose
 named shall hire out the said woman Sylvia & her
 future increase from year to year, and divide the
 proceeds after deducting a reasonable compensation
 for their trouble between my above said daughters
 Nancy & Martha equally - The said woman Sylvia & the
 proceeds of her hire not in any way to be subject to the
 control of either of the husbands of Nancy Wright

control of either of the husbands of Nancy Wright
& Martha Binns. further than they the said Nancy
& Martha may voluntarily choose to give over the proceeds
from the said hire from year to year. If Both of the
above named Trustees should refuse to act it is my
will & desire that the County Court of New Kent should
appoint some discrete person to execute the said Trust.
Item I leave all my perishable estate to be sold by my
executor, or ~~either~~ representative as soon after my death
as convenient & the proceeds thereof together with what
may be owing to me, to be equally divided between my
three grand children. Namely, Luitilda Wright, Saml Dennis
Binns and Mary Elizabeth Howle - after the payment of
debts & funeral expences. Item I constitute & appoint Thos
E. Davis & Robert Howle executors to this my last will & Tes-
tament. Witness my hand & seal this 29th day of March 1836.

Codicil

Not having finally decided the negro woman Sylvia
named in the above will, I hereby make & ordain this
codicil to my will as above intending & wishing it to
be taken as a part thereof. Item my negro woman

Sylvia & her future increase to be hired out for the purpose named in the first part of this my will during the life time of my two daughters Nancy Wright and Martha Birns & in the event of the death of either (Nancy or Martha) the half of the hire to be given to the children of the deceased one & the surviving one to have the other half of the hire during her life & after the death of both Nancy Wright & Martha, I will & desire that the said woman Sylvia & her future increase shall be sold (& have the liberty of choosing a master provided she can get any one to give a fair price for her) and the proceeds of such sale, I give & bequeath to be equally divided between the surviving children of the said Nancy Wright & Martha Birns to them & their heirs forever.
