I Richard B. Taylor of the County of New Kent, Virginia, hereby
revoking all wills heretofore made by me do make this my
last will and Testament in manner and form follow-
ing that is to say, First, I give and devise to my niece
Julia H. Hockaday my farm on Pamunkey river known
and called Pegs Point supposed to contain two hundred
and twenty five acres be the same more or less during
her life and at her death to her descendants to be di-
vided between them "per stirpes" should any of the said
Julia H. Hockaday's descendants living at her death die
before him she or they alive to the age of twenty one years
it is my will that in that event the portions of those so
dying shall descend and pass to the surviving descend-
ants of my said Niece "per stirpes" if those so dying leave
no child or descendants, and if my said Niece should
leave living at her death no child or descendants it is
my will that said land Pegs Point go to my Niece
Betty W. Mitchell with like limitations as to her and her
descendants - Secondly I give and devise to my Niece
Betty W. Mitchell my two tracts of land the one

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which I now reside supposed to contain one hundred and sixty four acres more or less and a tract of land adjoining the said land on which I reside known and called Hays, supposed to contain one hundred and eighteen acres, be the same more or less with like limitations over to her descendants descendants and to Julia H Hockaday as are before mentioned in reference to the land herein before devised to said Julia H Hockaday and her descendants. Thirdly - I give to my sister Lucy B. Vaiden two hundred dollars to be held in trust by my Executors herein after named for her sole and separate use free from the control or debts of her husband.

Fourthly - I give to my niece aforesaid Julia H Hockaday to be held in like manner and with like limitations and conditions as to the said land in favor of her descendants and Betty W Hockaday my Negro man William. Fifthly - I give to my niece aforesaid Betty W Mitchell to be held in like manner and with like limitations and conditions the said land devised her in favor of her descendants and said Julia H Hockaday my Negro woman Jane.

Sixthly - It is my will and desire that all my other personal and my perishable property be sold and the proceeds thereof together with all and any other real or personal estate which I may die seized and possessed

proceeds thereof together with all and any other real
or personal estate which I may die seized and possessed
of equally divided between my two Nieces before named
with like limitations and conditions as to the land
herein before devised therein in favor of their descend-
ants and each other. Seventhly, It is my will and
desire that my Land be not sold under any state
of facts and circumstances. Lastly, I hereby nomi-
nate constitute and appoint my friends Geo. L.
Bowles and Thos S. Morris & Executors of this my last
will and testament. Given under my hand and
seal this the 31st day of August in the year 1858
