will and testament. First, I wish all my just debts which are ^{due} at my death
to be paid, Second, I desire all of my personal and real estate to be sold
and the proceeds to be divided between James Walls, Robert E. Walls, Emma
N. Walls, Corilla Hubbard and Ella Stuart. they being my children. I do
not give to John B. Walls my son, anything as I have already bestowed
upon him so much of my estate as I desire him to have viz. the place
upon which I now live and a deed for which I have ^{in deed} ~~in deed~~ to him this
day. The proceeds of my Estate both real and personal are to be divided

amongst the aforesaid James Walls, Robert Walls, Emma Hubbard, Loretta Hubbard
and Ella Stewart be that James Walls, Robert Walls, and Emma Hubbard are to have
the same amounts and Emma Hubbard is to have two hundred dollars less than
either James Walls, Robert Walls or Ella Stewart and Loretta Hubbard is to have sixty
dollars and twenty cents less than either James Walls, Robert Walls, or Ella Stewart.
I further provide that in the event that I should have to pay to O Ball the amount due
on bond executed to him by Boler Hubbard and to which I am security for the sum
of two hundred dollars then the amount which I shall pay on said bond is to be
