In The name of God Amen, I Roland Jones of The County of New Kent, State of Va. of sound and disposing mind, do this day make this as my last Will and Testament as follows: That is to say. I leave to my wife Octavia H Jones during her life-time The houses and one third of The farm upon which I live: The other two thirds of said farm I give to my son Roland H. Jones. Should my son Roland H Jones die without lawful issue of The body and before my wife Octavia H Jones I then give The entire farm and tenements to my wife Octavia H Jones. I then give and should my wife Octavia H Jones

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my son Roland B. Jones. I then give the entire personal and tena-
ments to my son R. B. Jones. 2ndly. I give to my grandson Harrison
 Jones the tract of land called Simbelake's family owned by
 David H. Simbelake, 3rdly. I desire all of my personal effects consis-
ting of stock of various descriptions, crops, household and kitchen
furniture farming utensils money bonds notes. or any other
 pieces of writing or species of property that shall be in my possession
 of due me at the time of my decease. shall be equally divided
 between my wife Aetavia H. Jones, my son Roland H. Jones and
 my grandson Harrison Jones. I now nominate and appoint my
 wife Aetavia H. Jones as executrix of this my last will and tes-
 tament and for the performance of which duties I do not re-
 quire her to give any security

 and Testament have set my hand and seal this the 29th of Nov.
 one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine

and a certificate is granted her for obtaining a probate of
the said will in due form of law.
