Leach of the County of New Kent and State of Virginia, being of sound mind and disposing mind do hereby make and ordain this to be my last will and testament viz: I desire my body to be decent interred and my funeral charges and my just debts to be paid by my after named Executor. I do give to my daughter Margaret C. Smith my dwelling house and three hundred acres of my land. The rest of my land I give to my daughter Mary A. Leach. Lastly I appoint my friend Dr. L. A. Slater my Executor to this my last will and testament. Given under my hand and testament seal this the 18 day of October Eighteen hundred 1888.

In New Kent County Court April 9<sup>th</sup> 1891.

The last will and testament of R. P. Leach deceased was presented in Court and there being no subscribing witnesses thereto. Weifman and Dr. L. A. Slater were sworn and severally deposed that they are well acquainted with the testator's hand writing and truly believe the said writing and the name thereto subscribed to be wholly written by the testator's own hand, whereupon the said writing is ordered to be recorded as the true last will and testament of the said R. P. Leach deceased.
