do make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former
wills by me made. First I give to my daughter Betty Anderson all my
land situated in said County and adjoining the lands of Mrs Higgin and
others to her the said Betty Anderson and to her heirs for ever.

Second. I loan to my daughter Betty Anderson my two beds and my cow
together with all all other property I may possess at the time of
my death with the exception of one dollar in cash. and at the death
of said Betty Anderson I give the property loaned to her. to her children
to be equally divided between them. Third; I give to my son William
Jeffries one dollar in cash. lastly I appoint my friend Thos L. Trustall
Executor to this my last will an Testament March 15th 1861
