I, Warren C. Cumber, of the County of New Kent and State of Virginia,
being of Sound mind and disposing memory, do make and
publish this as and for my last will and testament as follows -
1st After my funeral expenses, Charges for Administration and
my just debts shall have been paid (all of which must be paid
out of my personal property or out of wood or lumber on the
farm) I give to my daughter Ann R. Brisley \$5- and to my Son
John Cumber \$5- that is to say, I give to them \$5- each and
nothing else. 2nd I give to my grand-son, Warren A. Cumber, one
bed and Stead, and to my grand daughter Delcinea H. Cumber
one bed and Stead, 3rd Whatever shall remain of my personal
estate I give to my Son Andrew H. Cumber. And I leave to my
Son Andrew H. Cumber all of my real estate (including the
buildings thereon) during his life and then to his children and
their descendants. Let Sarah Martha D. Cumber, wife of my
Son Andrew H. Cumber survive him I leave said real estate to

her long as she shall remain his widow, but at death or
should she marry again I leave said real estate to the children
of my son Andrew H. Gummer and to their descendants 4th My shares
are due Martha D. Gummer wife of my son A. H. Gummer for faithfully
keeping house for me at my own request and for other services
rendered for about nine years to date and for which she has received
nothing. I direct that my son Andrew H. Gummer shall not be held
responsible for the use he has had of the farm and buildings.

I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Andrew H. Gummer my
executor of this my last will and testament, and desire that no security
shall be required of him. 7th Any other will that may have been heretofore
made is hereby revoked. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my

eight hundred and eighty six.
