I, William B. Crump of the County of New Kent, being of sound and disposing mind, do make this my last will and Testament as follows:
First: After all of my just debts are paid, I leave to my wife Martha B. Crump, during her single life all of my property of every description whatsoever. Second:

I hereby appoint my wife, Martha B. Crump, my executrix to this my last will and Testament, and my express wish is that the Court will not require security of her in qualifying as such.
