1864-1866
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In the name of God amen. I William B. Menefee of the County of New Kent County, being of sound mind do make this to be my last will and testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.

- 1st. I wish my entire estate to remain together as it now stands for the maintenance and support of wife as long as she lives.
2. At the death of my wife, I lend to my daughter during her life my entire estate not subject to be taken for any debt that has been or may be contracted by her husband, and at her death to be equally divided among her children.

Given under my hand and seal this the 24 day of March Eighteen hundred and Sixty six.
