I William Bond of the County of New Kent ss make and constitute this my last will & testament. 1st I give to my daughter Bettie Washington Phillips the house in which I now live and fifty acres of land round about the house. in one body to be selected and laid off in obedience to her wishes and directions. I also give to my aforesaid daughter one Cow called Cherry, my horse, cart and gear. one bedstead bed and bedding therefor. (her choice) one cup-board & the crockery and hardware therein. one large sideboard and one clock. also all of the fodder and one third of the corn that I may have at the time of my death - also one walnut table - 2nd I give to my Grand-son William, H. Haggerty, thirty acres of land adjacent to that given to my daughter Bettie. I also give him one cow. The bedstead and bedding that is in my room. and also one third part of the Corn that I may have on hand at the time of my death - also one small looking glass. I also give to him my watch. - 3rd. The ballance of my lands, not herein before disposed of. I give jointly and equally to my two sons Thomas Bond and Martin Bond - 4th. To my son Thomas Bond. I give one Cow. and one bedstead bed & bedding therefor. and one third part of the Corn that I may have on hand. at the time of my death. 5th. I give to my daughter Bettie all of my hogs. 6th. The ballance if any. of my property, be it what it may. I give equally to my daughter Bettie W. Phillips. my sons Thomas and Martin. and my grand-son W. H. Haggerty & direct my executor to sell the same and divide the proceeds thereof among them. Lastly - I nominate and appoint Thomas Bailey executor of this my last will and testament and request the Court to allow him to qualify as such without requiring him to give any security.
