In the name of God amen, I William F. Atkinson, being in health but in good sound and disposing mind do make and ordain this my last will and testament after paying my funeral charges and all my just debts I lend to my beloved wife Elizabeth M. Atkinson during her life all my estate both real and personal to use to her benefit should the income of my estate not enough to support her and her family. She may sell any part of my estate real or personal to live on. After my wifes death, I give one half of my estate to Margaret D. Odell, both real and personal. I give the other half of my estate to James M. Sweney should he remain with my wife Elizabeth M. Atkinson as long as she lives or until said James reaches twenty one years old. Should he said James M. Sweney leave my wife before his death or becomes twenty one years old or do not help her all he can or dies before he is twenty one years of age, in that case his half of my estate shall go to Margaret D. Odell her and her heirs forever. Given under my hand and seal this the ninth day of January, Eighteen hundred and Sixty five.
