In the name of God, amen, I, William F. Rabinow being of perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament, revoking all others:- I leave unto my beloved wife, Hannah E. Rabinow, after all my just debts are paid one half of my estate during her natural life and at her death to be equally divided between such children as she may have by me, and the other half of my estate I wish to be equally divided among said children at my death. I leave my beloved wife Executrix of this my last will and Testament, desiring the Court to require of her no security for the same.
