

I The undersigned William M. Ferrell do make this my last
 will and testament. 1st - I desire all my just debts, and
 all proper expenses paid - 2nd - I give and bequeath all my
 property and Estate of every kind and description to my
 wife Judith M. Ferrell, and my child Oliver M. Ferrell
 to be enjoyed and used by them jointly severally and
 in common, just as my said wife shall deem best and
 proper, without any restriction, or limitation until my
 said child shall attain the age of eighteen years or
 or die before attaining 18 years or my said wife shall
 die, or marry again prior to my said child attaining
 the age of eighteen years - 3rd - If my said child shall
 attain 18 years of age before dying or the marriage or
 death of my said wife, I desire all my said property
 and Estate then remaining unused as aforesaid,
 shall be equally divided between my said wife and
 child - 4th - If my said child shall die before she attain
 the age of 18 years, and before the death or marriage of
 my wife as aforesaid, in that event, I give all my Estate
 then remaining, to my said wife - 5th - If my said wife
 dies before my said child shall attain the age of 18
 years, or dies before my said wife marries then I give
 all my Estate remaining at the time of the death of
 my said wife, to my said child - 6th - If my said wife
 shall marry during the life of my said child, and before

my said wife, and my said child, and my said child shall manage during the life of my said child, and before she attain ^{the age of 18 years}, upon the said marriage I give one third of my property and estate then remaining to my said wife, and the other two thirds to my said child to be divided at that time - &c - I hereby nominate and appoint my said wife Judith M. Penell the sole executrix of this my last will and testament and hereby invest and empower her as said executrix, with the right and authorize her to sell and dispose of any and all of my property and estate I may own at the time of my death or to exchange or invest the same, or any part thereof, at any time, in any way, on any terms, at or in any place or state, she shall choose or determine, to collect, or loan any part thereof, or rent out any part, in any way, or on any terms, to compromise or settle any claim or claims in my favor or that may be set up against me, to settle up any partnership I am interested in on any term or in any way, she may decide, she as said executrix is hereby invested with exclusive and entire management and controll of all of said matters and affairs and to manage them in such a manner as she shall determine and think best, subject to the provisions of this will, I expressly invest her with the power to carry out and execute the provisions of this will, and charge her to perform them faithfully. I hereby release her as said executrix, from

giving or executing any bond, as said executing of their will or
 for the performance of the duties thereof and authorize the grant
 to her of Letters Testamentary without her giving bond. Given
