

In the Name of God amen I Amos Elthorpe of the County of Norfolk in the Colony of Virginia being
well Stricken in years But in Sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be to almighty God; and knowing that
it is appointed to all men once to dye I do make and ordains this my Last Will and Testament in manner
and forme as followeth, First, I Bequeath my Soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it - and my Body
to the Earth whence it was taken, to be Decently Buried in a Christian like manner, at the discretion of
my Executors hereafter mentioned - And for all the worldly Estate that it hath pleased almighty God to Bless me
with I do give and Bequeath in manner and forme as followeth, -----
I Give unto my Loving wife Bothrich Elthorpe the use and Benefitt of house and plantation whereon I now live with
one hundred Acres of Land and appurtenances during her Natural life, and not to be Interrupted Disturbed or Molested by
any person what so Ever during her Natural life -----
I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Amos Elthorpe after the Decease of my wife the plantation whereon I now live with one
hundred acres of Land and appurtenances being the Land and plantation that was given to me by my father William Elthorpe
to him my said Son Amos Elthorpe and his heirs for Ever -----
I Give and Bequeath unto my Loving wife Bothrich Elthorpe Fifty acres of Land with the appurtenances being the land I
bought of Joseph Hedges as by the record of Norfolk County will appeare be the same more or Less to her and her heirs for
Ever I also Give unto my Loving wife Bothrich Elthorpe Two Negro Boys Namely Swash and George to her and her
heirs for Ever I also Give unto my said wife the Bed and furniture whereon she lieth being the Bed that is kept here to her
heirs for Ever -----
I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Joseph Edwards one Bed and furniture the cattle and Sheep that she has
put already into her possession, to her and her heirs for Ever -----
I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Martha Bortlock the Bed and furniture Two Knives and Cutlers Two Cows and
Calves one pecker Dish, one Iron pot and one womens saddle all which she has put already into her possession, to her
and her heirs for Ever -----
I Leave the use of my land mill and me overleth to my wife during her natural life and after her Decease I give the said
mill and Fulling Dought Martha Bortlock during her natural life and after her Decease to her children, to them and
there heirs for Ever -----

I leave the use of my land mill and one cow to my wife Betiah
mill and I leave my daughter Martha Portlock during her natural life and after her decease to her children to them and
there heirs for ever

And also the remaining part of my Estate of what lands so I owned before given away I do leave after my last
debts paid to my Loving wife Betiah Eltheridge to live upon and make use of at her own pleasure with out any interruption
of any person what so ever during her natural life and what shall remaine after her decease to be Equally divided by
her children my two Daughters that is to say Joseph Edwards and Martha Portlock and there heirs for ever
And For the true performing of every part of this my last Will and Testament I do ordaine and appoint my Loving
Wife Betiah Eltheridge and my friend Thomas Edwards wholly and joyntly Executor and Custodian of this my last Will
and Testament In Witness where of I have hereunto set my hand and put my seal this Third day of September One
Thousand seven hundred and Sixty
