Life to make and Ordain this my Last Will & Testament in the
following Manner & form Viz^t First and principally I have given
my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God who gave it me and
my Body to the Earth to be decently Buried at the Discretion of
my Executors hereafter Named, And as touching such Worldly
Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow Upon me I do give and
Dispose thereof as follows —

Viz^t I do give and bequeath unto my Son Phadrick Wyatt
One Feather Bed and Furniture thereunto belonging, Three Hunt
Dishes five Hunter Plates One Basin and One painted Tankard
One Iron Pot and Spitt One Pan and One Spout One Table and

Skillet

I do Give and bequeath unto my Granddaughter Amy Harris One
Silver Dish One Silver Basin Ditto and three Plates and one Iron pot

I do Give and bequeath unto my Son Shadrach Wyatt All my Land
to him and his Heirs forever

I do Give unto my Children whose Names follow to each of them
One Shilling Sterling with Intent to put them off from claiming any
part of my Estate vizt my Daughters Jane Harris, Amy Jenkins, Mary
Collins, my Son John Bruce, Ann Ward, Margaret Spiers, Sarah Bishop

Collins, my Son John Baines, Ann Ward, Margaret Spiars, Sarah Bishop
and Alice Norcott

Item my Will and Desire is that all such of my Estate which is not
already Given shall be Equally Divided between my Son Shadrack
and John Wyatt after all my Just and Lawful Debts are Paid and
Discharged — Furthermore I do Nominate constitute and appoint
my Son Shadrack Wyatt full and Sole Executor of this my Last Will

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Tesament and And do hereby make Void and Disannul all former
Will and Wills by me heretofore made And declaring this to be my last
Will In Testimony Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this day
and Date first Above Written Signed Sealed pronounced & Declared in
