- I Give and Bequeath unto my Grandson Baly Warren Son of William Warren & Mary his Wife one feather Bedstead and furniture, Likewise one square table one Butler Candle Stick on Large Chest, and halfe a dozen plate Plates and one young Cow Give them To him and his heirs for ever After my Decease.
- I Give to my Grandson William Warren Son of William Warren and Mary his wife one Bed and furniture one Chest and one young Cow I Give them To him And his heirs for ever after my Decease.
- I Give and Bequeath To My Granddaughter Frances Warren Daughter of William Warren and Mary his Wife one young Cow one small Iron pot and one Butler Dish I Give them to her And her heirs for ever After my Decease.
- I Give and Bequeath to my Granddaughter Elizabeth Warren Daughter of John Warren and Elizabeth his wife one Shilling in full of her Portion.
- I Give and Bequeath To my Grandson Son Willis Warren Son of John Warren and Elizabeth his wife one Shilling in full of his Portion.
- I Give and Bequeath to my Grandson John Warren Son of John Warren and Elizabeth his wife one Shilling in full of his Portion.
- I Give and Bequeath to my Grandson Samuel Warren Son of John Warren and Elizabeth his wife one Shilling in full of his Portion.
- I Give by Use of all the Remainder of my Estate that is Not all Ready Given to My Daughter Mary Warren her Life time and After her Decease for to be Equally Divided Between And Among Phillip and Charles Warren Children to William Warren and Mary his wife.
- Lastly It is my Will and I Do Ordain And Appoint My Son in Law William Warren my sole and sole Executor of This my Last will and testament And I Do here by Revok Disannul and Make void all former wills.
