will not reject me, a returning penitent sinner.

When I come to him for Mercy: with hope and confidence I
pour up my soul with Comfort humbly beseeching the Most
Blessed and Glorious Trinity one God, Most Holy Most Merciful
and gracious to prepare ~~me~~ for the time of my Dissolution and
then to take me to himself, into that peace and rest and the
comparable plenty which he has prepared for all that love
and fear his holy Name Amen ~~Wishing~~ I promise
I give my body to the Earth from whence it was taken, In full
Assurance of its resurrection from thence at the
Last Day: as for my Burial I desire it may be decent with-
out pomp or State at the direction of my Loving Bre-
ther Executor here after Mentioned who I doubt not will
manage it with all regards of Prudence, and for my

Worldly Estate I will and positively order that all my Just
Debts be paid: Next my will and desire is that my Sister
Mary Quaries shall have ^{my} Negro Girl named Sarah

Monday Estate I will and positively order that all my Just
Debts be paid. Next my will and desire is that my sister
Mary Lucas shall have ^{my} Negro Girl named Hannah
to her Heir or Assigns for Ever. Likewise my will and
Desire is that my Brother John Hudson should receive, Inhe-
rit and Enjoy all my part of my father's Estate which now
is or here after may become ~~of~~ me without any Delay
or Interruption of any person or persons whatsoever to him
his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do constitute and ap-
point my Loving Brother John Hudson my Executor of
this my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth Day of Aug-
ust in the Year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hun-
dred and Eighty 1780
