calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body, & knowing
that it is Appointed for all men Once to Die, do make and
Ordain this my Last Will and Testament

First I Give and bequeath unto Frances my beloved Wife
One Feather Bed, Bedstead and Furniture, One Iron pot
and Tiring Pan Six Jeweled Plates and two Jeweled Dishes
her Phoenix of two paws and balver the Gang of Hogs I raised
On the Plantation I now Live Upon, All the Above I Give to
the said Frances my Wife for ever I likewise Give unto my
Wife Frances all the Corn in or out of the Ground for ever
also I Give — to Frances my Wife the Use of the Half Mile
lying along my House the Use of of two Niggers & 1st Nigro

Man named Lazar and a Negro Girl named Hannah
the Use of the House and Plantation I live upon (that
part my Son Anthony lives upon Excepted) During her
Natural life

Also I Give and bequeath unto my Son Joseph Gurling
One Negro man named Charles to be delivered unto him at
the Expiration of one whole Year after my Decease to
him his Heirs or Assigns I likewise Give my Son Joseph
One Gun, and a Stand Mill after the Decease of Francis
my Wife

Also I Give and bequeath to my Son John the Plantation
I bought of William Wallard containing One Hundred &
fifty Acres more or Less to him his Heirs or Assigns forever
I likewise Give and bequeath to my Son John to be delivered
unto him at the Expiration of one whole Year after my

Decease One Negro Named Sam to him & his Heirs or Assigns
Also I Give and bequeath to my Son Daniel One Negro Named
George to him his Heirs or Assigns.

Also I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ed Smith
after the Decease of Frances my Wife One Negro Named
Hannah with her Increase to her and her Heirs.

Also I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Betty Ann
Lockhart One Negro Named Phillis to her and her Heirs
I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Martha Fox Fox and
her Mary of Virginia to be paid unto her at the Age of
Twenty One or at the time of her Marriage by my Exor^r
out of my Estate left to him for that and other purposes here
after mentioned.

Lastly all the Residue and Remainder of my Estate not

Also I Give and bequeath to my Son Daniel One Negro Named
George to him his Heirs or Assigns.

Also I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ed Smith
after the Decease of Frances my Wife One Negro Named
Hannah with her Increase to her and her Heirs.

Also I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Betty Ann
Lockhart One Negro Named Phillis to her and her Heirs
I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Martha F. Founds-
port Money of Virginia to be paid unto her at the Age of
Twenty One or at the time of her Marriage by my Exec^r
out of my Estate left to him for that and other purposes here
after mentioned.

Lastly all the Residue and Remainder of my Estate not
above bequeathed Together with such things as are hereunder

Named I Give to pay my Lawful Debts and funeral charges (318)
and the Above Mentioned Legacy of Ten pounds to my Daughter
Martha, that is to say I Give and bequeath unto my Son Anthony
(he paying such Debts as last Above Mentioned) (ie) a Negro Named
Cazar after the Decease of my Wife the Use of two Negroes and
whole Year after my Decease the House and Plantation I
now Live Upon After the Decease of Frances my Wife to him
his Heirs or Assigns forever I Likewise Give to my Son Anthony
whom I constitute make and Ordain my Sole Executor of this
my Last Will and Testament One Negro man Named James to
him his Heirs or Assigns forever And I do hereby Utterly Dis-
allow & Revoke all other former Testaments & Bequests
Notifying and confirming this and no other to be my Last Will
and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand and Seal the day and Year first Above Written —
