the age of Twenty one years or on the Day of Marriage, &
to her Heirs for ever -

I give & bequeath unto my said Wife Martha. During her
Natural life my Negro Woman Moll. also my best bed &
furniture, and all my Pewter & Kitchen furniture, to her
& her Heirs, and at my Wifes Decease I give my said Ne-
gro Moll to my Daughter Blandina. & to her Heirs for ever

I give & bequeath to my Son Hancock Moreley my Negro Boy Cesar,
I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Blandina Moreley two
Gold Rings. one Gold Locket. & one Silver Chain. which was her
Mothers. & are sealed up. with my said Daughter's Name wrote
on them. also five Silver Tea spoons Mark'd A.A. -

My Will & Desire is that all my Household Goods. according y^m
I have given to my Wife Martha. & my Daughter Blandina may be
sold for Money. & to be equally Divided between my Wife. & my
Son Hancock. and my Daughter Blandina. This likewise my Will
is that my Negro Man Jack may be sold unto the
best advantage, and the money be applied towards a dowry

ing. my Wife & two Children. That my said Wife Martha desire
my Will is. that my said Negro Jack, and all my all
may be as equally Divided as can be. Between my son Ham-
cock and Daughter Blandinah -

Item I give & bequeath unto my loving Wife Martha, my son
Hancock & my Daughter Blandinah, all my Debts, Goods, Wares
and whatsoever else I have not in this my Will given away to be
equally Divided Between y^m share & share alike. & whatever shall
appear to be of equal parts of my son Hancock & my Daughter
Blandinah. shall be put out to Interest for and the support and
maintainance of them till they shall attain to 21 years of Twenty
one years or y^e Day of Marriage & if either of my said Children
shall die before he or she is of full age or y^e Day of Marriage
my Will is. that y^e survivor shall have the deceaseds full &
quall share. paid to them and their Heirs -

My Will & desire is that my loving Wife Martha Money shall
have y^e care & Education of my Daughter Blandinah. But in
case my said Wife shall Marry again. & there shall be any
unwillingness to, or Complaint of my Daughter Blandinah that then
she shall be committed to y^e care and Tuition of my loving
Friends. Richard Taylor & his Wife Elizabeth Taylor. & they or
y^e survivor of them. shall demand & receive y^e profits of the
Hires of my said Negro Jack. and all other of my said Daugh-
ter Blandinahs Estate. to bring her up till y^e Day of Mar-
riage. or to y^e age of Twenty one years -

I do hereby revoke all former Wills by me made and appoint my
Loving Wife Martha Money, Executrix. & Richard Smith. & Richard
Taylor Executors. of this my last Will & Testament. In Witness Whereof
