Make and ordain this to be my Last will and Testament that
is to say Principally and First of all I give and recommend
my soul ⁱⁿ to the hands of God that gave it, and my Body to the
Earth of which all the Bodies of men was made and must return
Desiring to be Buried in a Christian Form Executors and
as Touching such Worldly Goods or Estate as it hath Pleased God
To bestow or Bless me with in this Life I Give devise and Dis-
pose In some Form and Following Manner — " — "
First I Give to my Dearly beloved Wife Lydia Lane All that is known

that she Brought with her when we were Married Likewise all
 the Meat and corn and all such things that is Growing that is
 Known to be mine and the Half of Every thing that we have got
 or Gathered since we were Married Likewise her share of Two
 Cows and calves or yearlings and her choice of one horse
 and all the Hags that is known to be mine and
 To her and her heirs for ever and on conditions the aforesaid
 Lydia Lane my dearly beloved Wife should die Before me
 For her Children to have and Enjoy such things as belongs
 To their Mother, When I Married her or such as can be found
 and Nothing Else besides Also I Give to my Beloved ~~son~~
 son Augustus Lane all that he is Possess with and the
 Half of breascut saw to him and his heirs for ever
 I also Give to my Daughter Abel padon all that she
 is Possess with only a Bill that I have of William padon
 all that she hath Besides the Bill to her and her heirs
 forever. D. A. Lane

is Defunct with only a Bill that I have of William Padon
all that she hath Besides the Bill to her and her heirs
Forever, I Also Give to my Daughter Sarah Sumner
all that she is Defunct with Except a Bill I have of Geo.
Sumner all that the aforesaid Sarah Sumner ^{hath beside}
the Bill to her and her heirs for Ever

Also I Give to my son Robert Lane a feather bed which
I have all ready Sent him to him and his heirs for Ever
and After all my Lawfull Debts are Paid

I also Give to my Two sons Solomon Lane and Gibson
Lane the rest of my Estate to be Divided Between them Two
only for my son ~~Solomon~~ ^{of Gibson} to have Eight Pound Most Silver
to them and their heirs for Ever

I Likewise Appoint Joshua a Lawrence my soul Execu-
tor of this my Last will and Testament and I do there-
by Disannul all other Wills and Testaments before made
or mentioned I do therefore Acknowlege this to
be my last Will and Testament and no other -

Eleventh Day of October one Thousand Seven hundred
and Seventy six
