once to die, I recommend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God, who
gave it me, hoping at the General Resurrection that I shall receive it
again by the same Almighty Power that gave it, as for my Body I commit
to the Earth there to be decently buried at the direction of my Executor, and
as touching such Worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow on me in
this World, I do give & bequeath it in a Manner and Form following.

Item It is my Will be so order all my just Debts & funeral Charges shall be paid.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Friend Joyce Wither the Sum of Twenty
four pounds Curr: money of Eng: to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Friend Edward Colly the Sum of Six
pounds Curr: money as aforesaid, with all my Debts that ^{is} now due
to me for to carry on a Suit that is now depending for the Recovering of my
£1000 of the said Edward Colly

to me for to carry on a Suit that is now depending for the recovery of my
Fathers Estate in Negroes that he was possessed withall when he deceased.
Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Friend Sander Golly son of Ew?
Golly, one Negro Boy, if recoverable which suit is now depending &
and the remainder to be delivered to my beloved friend Joyce Miller
she dying without lawfull issue of her Body to be adjudged to be my
lawfull heir, then it is my Will and I do order that my beloved Uncle
Edward Golly may have the said Negroes to him & his heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Friend John Golly son of Edward
Golly, one Coat and Breaches, a hatt & Whigg to him & his heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Friend Edward Golly all my
Estate both real and personall that is not already given, to him &
his heirs for ever.

Lastly it is my Will and I do order and appoint my beloved friend
Edward Golly to be my whole & sole Executor of this my last Will and
Testament and I do revoke & annul and make void all other former
Wills and Legacies by me so granted whatsoever, I Testimony

Wherefore I have said Christopher Saller have hereunto set my hand
and Seal this day and year above Written.

Norfolk County, the Court held the 21st day of September 1744:—
The last Will and Testament of Christopher Saller was this day proved
by the Oaths of William Johnson and John Davenport and ordered to
be recorded, and the Executor therein named having taken the Oath &

granted him on the said Will.
