the County of Norfolk and Colony of Virginia being in perfect
Sense and Memory Desires to dispose of my Worldly Goods as
followeth First I bequeath my Soul to God that gave it and
my Body to the Earth in full hopes of a Future Resurrection and to
be buried in a Christian Manner According to the Discretion of my
Executors &c

Item I Give unto William Gurdy Son of my Brother William
Gurdy the Rem. and part of my Plantation where I now dwell
and the Rem. and part of the Woodland on that side of the River
Branch Called the Ready Branch as I have not given by Deed of Gift
in Norfolk County the same I Give unto William Gurdy & his heirs forever

Item I Give unto George Griffin Son of John Griffin the 306
remainder part of my Land on the East Side of that Rudy Branch
having a Small House and Corn field on it and live in Princeps
County, to him the said George Griffin and and his heirs
forever —

Item I Give to William Selvester and Francis Gamewell Daughter
of James Fortson One Negro man Called Jack and to be Divided
Equally as they will Agree in Sale of the Negro from One to
the Other to them and their Heirs forever —

Item I Leave my two Negro Women Nan and Bess on the Planta-
tion during their Lives at pleasure —

Item I Give all the Rest of my Estate Excepting the Negroes to be
Equally Divided between my four ^{daughters} ~~children~~ Francis Fortson
Elizabeth Brooks & Dinah Ward and Elizabeth Lee to them &
their Heirs —
