Item I give and bequeath unto my Brother John one Negro named Phel-
bey and one Negro named Dennis during his Natural Life
and if he die without Heir then I give the said Negroes Phel-
bey and Dennis unto John and Nancy Archdickons and
their Heirs

Item I give unto my Brother William one Negro Boy named Frank
during his natural Life and if he die without Heir then I give
the said Negro Boy Frank to be equally divided amongst M^r
Archdickons Children

being his natural def and if he die without heir then I give
the said Negro Boye Frank to be equally divided amongst Mr.
Archdickons Children

Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister Pernell one large cedar
Chest and such part of my wearing Appairil as she shall like

Item I give unto my Brother John one Desk and ^{one} large Silver Spoon.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister Tabitha one large Silver
Spoon and one Pair Silver Sugar Tongis and half Dozⁿ of China
Plates and one small cedar Chest and such part of wearing
Appairil as shall be left by my Sister Pernell

Item I give and bequeath unto my Brother William one Feather
Bed and half Dozⁿ hard Mattill Platts one China Bowl
and four Silver Tea Spoons and four Walnut Chairs and one
cedar Taball.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister Tabitha one Mahogany
Bedstead and half Dozⁿ cedar Chairs

Item I give and bequeath unto John Archdickon one Gold moss-
=ning ~~thing~~ Ring

Item I give and bequeath unto Selley Archdickon one pair of
Stone Shoe Buckels

Item I give and bequeath unto Sukey Archdickon one pair Silver

Shoe Buckles

I give unto my Sister Tabitha after all just Debt and funeral Charges he paid all the Money that shall be due to me from Mr. Archdickon and John Ingram and eleven more to her you see

Item I give unto Nancy Ingram Wife of John Ingram one Silke Matt.

Item I give unto Nancy Ingram Wife of William Ingram one black Satten bloke and one red D^o and one Callico cover bed

and lastly my Will is that what negroes may fall to any of Mr. Archdickon's Children by the Death of my Sister Tabitha or Brothers John or William that may be kept by the surviving Brother untill the Children cum of age and I appoint and constitute my loving Brothers John and William Ingrams Executors of this my last Will and Testament I Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and affixed my Seal this Twenty Eighth Day of January one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven.

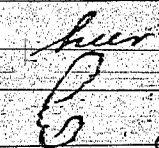
