

In the name of God Amen the 2. of May 1767-

I Richard Corner of Norfolk County Virg. being sick and weak in Body but of sound & perfect mind and Reasoning thanks be given to God do make & declare this my last Will & Testament in the following manner & Form

Item I do give & bequeath unto my loving Wife Katherine Corner the sum of £1000 (Ten hundred Pounds) Sterling & Mournings & Burials and had with her to her heirs forever. Immediately after my Death, & after my Dear Mothers decease, the slaves following Viz. Hanning, Peter, Joan, Sarah & Harry, to her & her heirs forever and also my two Wheelbarrow Chaises.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my Sister Margaret Corner all that Plantation she now lives upon formerly Daniel Rogers to her & her heirs forever after the death of all our parents & me Concerning the same Land.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my Godson Wm. Croford Wagner my Negroe Fellow to him & his heirs forever & my desire is that he shall be yearly paid out of his wages with the interest thereof to him when he is of full age.

Item I do give & bequeath unto Elizabeth Wagner daughter of Wm. & Elizabeth Wagner my Negroe Girl named Fanny to her & her heirs forever.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my Niece Ann Collings my Negroe Girl Betty Daughter of Wm. to her & her heirs forever.

Item My Will & desire is that my Dear Mother Abigail Corner do possess and Enjoy all my Estate of what kind soever (except the Slaves which came by my Wife & Chaise first Mentioned) for and during her Natural Life And afterwards when all my Debts are paid & discharged, I give the rest of my Slaves (not already given) unto my loving Brother Wm. Corner & to his heirs forever And all the Rest & Residue of my Estate after my Mothers Decease, to be Valued, and one third of the Value thereof given to my loving Wife aforesaid in Cash and the Remains to be equally divided between my Brother Wm. Corner and my Sister Eliz. Wagner.

Furthermore I do Nominate, Constitute and Appoint my loving Brother William Corner & my loving Wife Katherine Exrs. & Exrs. of this my Last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the Day and Date first above Written.
