

In the Name of God, Amen, I Daniel McCloud of the Borough
of Norfolk in the Colony of Virginia being sick and weak, but of sound and dispo-
-ing mind and Memory do make this my last Will and Testament in
manner and form following (viz) First I give and Recommend my Soul to
God and my Body to the Earth from whence it came and that to be Buried in
a Decent manner according to the Discretion of my Executors hereafter
mentioned and all my Estate both Real and personal I give and dispose
of as following.

First I give to my loving Wife Elizabeth the Use of my Lot and House whereon
I now live untill such time my son John arrives to the full age of Twenty
(and one years. Then ~~to~~ ^{his} him Heirs and Assigns for ever, and in case my son
John should dye before he arrives to the age aforesaid, then my Will and
desire is that the said House and Lot should descend to the next heir in Law
to them their Heirs and Assigns forever, and during their Minority to remain
in my Wife's possession as aforesaid.

Item I Give unto my said Wife the Use of a Negro Woman named Hannah During
her life and at her Decease my Will and Desire is that the said Negro Woman

and her Increase from this date should be equally Divided between my two Children John and Frances, to them their heirs and assigns forever.

Item I Give unto my said Wife Two of my best Beds & Furniture thereunto belonging Likewise all my flagg Bottomed Chairs, Likewise all my China & Delft, Earthen and Glass ware, whatsover, and Likewise One small Oak Walnut Table, and one Square Walnut Table, one old Desk and my small Bofett, also one pair of hand Irons and all my pewter in general and all the rest of my Kitching furniture whatsover. Likewise I give to her my bow, and two small looking Glasses & One Tea Chest and Two pair of flat Irons, and six silver Teaspoons and a Silver Tea Longs.

Item I Give unto my son John One Negro Boy named Tony to him his Heirs and assigns forever.

Item - I Give unto my Loving Daughter Frances one Negro Boy named Frank to her and her Heirs and assigns forever. and Likewise one small Tunnel Bed and Furniture to my said Daughter Frances.

Item My Will and desire is that all the Rest of my Estate both real and

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My Will and desire is that all the Rest of my Estate both real and
Personal be sold for the most that can be got by my Executors hereafter
mentioned and that Money arising therefrom after my Funeral Expences
and Debts are Discharged to be equally Divided among my Wife my
Son John and my Daughter Frances and my desire is further that
the Money coming to my two Children as aforesaid should be at my
wifes Disposal in giving them Education and bringing them up in
the fear of God — which God Grant they may. —

Lastly I Nominate and Appoint Capt. William Brange and Richard Taylor
and my Loving Wife Elizabeth, my Executors of this my Last Will and
Testament hereby revoking and making void all other and former Wills
heretofore by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand and Seal this Twentieth Day of August in the Year of our Lord
One thousand Seven hundred Sixty and three. — 1763.
