said Abigail Bruce to be well Clothed out of my Estate by
my Executors before she is put or bound out

Item It is my will and Desire, that all the Rest of my Estate
of Every Kind whatsoever, that I have not all Ready Given
away to be Equally Divided between my Beloved son
Samuel Rose and my beloved Daughter Fanny Rose
to them and their Heirs for ever After my Just & Lawful
Debts is paid

Item I Appoint and appoint my friend Ethelred Lancaster
and my friend Richard Powell, my whole, & sole Executors
to this my Last Will and Testament, In Witness where
of I have Hereunto set my hand & seal this sixteenth
Day of May One thousand seven hundred & ninety two
