In the Name of God Amen. February 17th 1763 I David Lambeth
of Norfolk County in the Colony of Virginia being Weak and Sick of
Body but of Perfect Mind and memory, thank be to God for calling
to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed
for all Men once to die do make and Ordain this to be my last
Will and Testament, Viz. first of all I give and recommend my Soul
into the Hands of God who first gave it me and as for my Body I
recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian Like and
Decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors Nothing Doubting
but I shall Receive the same by the Mighty Power of God and as

Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me
in this life, I give and Dispose in the following Manner and form. —
Item I give to my son Samuel Sambeth a piece of Land which I bought
of John Simmons pertaining ten Acres more or less to him & his Heirs forever.
And if my son Samuel Sambeth should Die without Heir I give the said
piece of Land to my son Thomas Sambeth to him and his Heirs forever.
And if my said son Thomas Sambeth should Die without Heir I give
the said Land to my son William Sambeth to him and his Heirs forever. —
Item I give to my son Samuel Sambeth my Gun and all the rest of my Mill to
him and his Heirs for ever. —
Item I give my son Thomas Sambeth my Pulling Stone Mill and if he should
Die without Heir I give the said Mill to my son William Sambeth to
him and his Heirs for ever. —
Item The rest of my Estate I Leave to be sold and my Money, and my Money
Debts to be Equally to be Divided between my Five Children Samuel
David, Thomas, Martha & William to be received when they come of age
which I have Fifteen pounds two Shillings in the Hands of the Executors and I
do make and ordain my loving Friends William Bowen and Joel Jackson my

Die without Heir I give the said Will to my son William Lambeth to
him and his Heirs for ever.

Item The rest of my Estate I Leave to be sold and my Money, and my Money
Debts to be Equally to be Divided between my Five Children Samuel
David, Thomas, Martha & William to be received when they comes of age
which I have Fifteen pounds two shillings in the Hands of the Executors and I
do make and ordain my loving Friends William Bowin and Joel Jackson my
sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament as Witness my Hand the
Day and Year first above Written.
