In the Name of God Amen. I David Wright of the Borough
of Norfolk now of Sound mind and Memory the late in Bodily Health
and well knowing the Uncertainty of this transitory Life do make
Publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament hereby
Revoking and making void all other Wills by me heretofore Made
I give and bequeath unto my Brother James Mordaugh all my
Land to him and his Heirs for ever upon condition he pay
Unto his Son Josiah Mordaugh Twenty Five Pounds and to
my Sister Anne Croft fifty Pounds and also to my mother
Twenty five Pounds in the whole Two hundred Pounds

Hand I give and bequeath unto my Mother all the Residue of my Estate of every
Kind seven years hence and as soon as I shall be able to do so
and lawfully thereby nominate and appoint my said Brother James Musgrave
my whole and Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this Fourth Day of
November 1771
