I also Give the rest and Residue of my Estate both Negroes, household Goods and Chattels of what Nature and kind so ever to my Son Mathew Godfrey and his Heirs forever and I do appoint my Son Mathew Godfrey my Sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament. Revoking and making Void all former Wills and Testaments by me made In Witness whereof I do set my Hand and Seal this 25th day of May in the Year of our Lord 1759. —
