desire is that said Land and plantations being one hundred and Ten Acres
shall Return to my son Rubin Creechmur to him and his heirs forever ~

Item. I Give and bequeath unto my Well beloved son Edmond Creechmur my Land and
Plantation whereon I now Live being one hundred and Ten Acres to him
and his heirs forever But my will and desire is that if my son Edmond
Creechmur should die without heir that my Land and plantations shall
Return to my son Rubin Creechmur to him and his heirs forever ~

Item. I Give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Mary Creechmur my Negro woman
called Fudge and one Mare and Colt the Mare called pigger to her and her
Disposal, Likewise I Give to my well beloved wife Mary Creechmur one
Feather Bed and furniture belonging to it to her and her disposal ~

Item. All the Rest of my Estate not mentioned after my Lawful debts are paid my
Will and Desire is shall be Equally Divided between my well beloved
Wife Mary Creechmur and my Daughter Abia Creechmur and my
Daughter Sarah Wright and my son Willis Creechmur & my son Edmond
Creechmur and my Daughter Mary Creechmur and my son Rubin L

Return to my son Rebin Creekmur to him and his heirs forever
 I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Mary Creekmur my Negro wench
 called Fudge and one mare and both the Mare calls pruggen to her and her
 Disposal, Likewise I give to my well beloved wife Mary Creekmur one
 Feather Bed and furniture belonging to it to her and her disposal
 All the Rest of my Estate not mentioned after my Lawful debts are paid my
 Will and Desire is shall be Equally Divided between my well beloved
 Wife Mary Creekmur and my Daughter Maria Creekmur and my
 Daughter Sarah Wright and my son Willis Creekmur & my son Edmond
 Creekmur and my Daughter Mary Creekmur and my son Ruben Creekmur
 I constitute and Ordain my well beloved Wife Mary Creekmur & my son
 Willis Creekmur and my son Edmond Creekmur to be my sole and sole
 Executors of this my Last will and Testament as witness my hand & seal,
 this 13th day of November 1774.
