and memory, thank be to Almighty God, I do hereby make this my
last Will and Testament in form and Manner following. viz.
I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Martha Etheridge all my
plantation that I lived on during her widowhood, and half of the
said plantation during her life time and if the Child my wife
now goes with in a son, I give the other half of the v: plantation
unto him for ever and after my Wife's death all the v: plantation
to him for ever and if the Child is not a son, I give the v: plantation
to my Daughter Parnice Etheridge in the same manner for ever and I
give unto my Daughter Parnice Etheridge one feather Bed & furniture
and one pewter dish and one pewter Basin and one Chalk and two
low Chair and one Iron pot and one Cow and forty shillings in
Cash to be delivered to her at the age of 18 or day of Marriage. —
I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Etheridge one feather
Bed and furniture and one pewter dish and one Basin and one Chalk and

two low Chairs, and Iron pot and one pound and forty shillings in
Cash to be delivered unto her at the age of 18 years or day of Marriage.
I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Etheridge and her
Bed and furniture and one pewter dish and a pewter Basin and one
Chest and two low Chairs, and Iron pot and forty shillings in Cash
to be delivered unto her at the age of 18 or day of Marriage.

And all the Remainder part of my personal Estate I give unto my
loving Wife Martha Etheridge and make her sole and sole Executor
of this my last Will and Testament, A Witness with my hand and Seal
this 20 day of March 1746.
