to the said Lewis Hatton and his wife Elizabeth Hatton shall remain joint,
posser and in joy all profits and Advantages that may arise
from them or the above said negroes untill the death of my Dearist
Sister Elizabeth Hatton a Lawfull wife of Lewis Hatton and then for the
said slaves to be Equally Divided among all the Children by the Will
of the Deceased. I'm Give and Give unto and be loved by me then I

to the said Lewis Hutton and his wife Elizabeth Hutton shall remain joint,
pousser and in joy all profits and Advantages that may arise
from them or the above said negroes untill the death of my Dearist
Sister Elizabeth Hutton a Lawfull wife of Lewis Hutton and then for the
said Slaves to be Equally Divided among all the Children by the last
of the Deced. I'm I give and Divise unto my beloved brother John
Goodrich my Negro wench sall with all her Children now living Except
the Two above boays above menchens, or Divise and the future
Incees of her body, like wise one son or still, I'm I give unto Joseph
Hodgston a son of wilm^m Hodgston the sum of Fifty Pounds for the yoes of his
Education, I'm all bonds of Caution & Counts down me from my Fair-
thers will offer all my Just & Counts be settled, I'm my father will
is that my Estat being thus Adjusted that my Brother John
Goodrich shall percieve and one Love Thirds of The Money
This my Last will & Testament in name of God
