her heirs for ever

to her and Her Heirs forever.

Item I give to my Grandson Charles mine Thurstons my Quaint
Silver Tankard to him and his Heirs after the Death of my
Daughter Elizabeth Thurston.

Item I give and devise to my Grandson John South of the Co^{ty} of Norfolk One
Negro Boy named Ben: also Fifty Pounds Current Money to him & his Heirs

I give and devise to my Grand Daughter Sarah Hatchings now
Wife to Joseph Hatchings of the Co^y of Norfolk I say I give her
One Negro Woman and all her Children with all their Issues I
likewise give the said Sarah Hatchings Fifty Pounds Current Money
of Virginia to her and her Heirs for ever

Item I give and devise to my Grandson Moses Robertson One Negro
Girl named Jane also I give the said Moses Fifty Pounds Current
of Virginia to Him and his Heirs for ever

Item I give and devise to my Grand Daughter Frances Robertson
One Negro Girl named Patty also I give the said Frances
Robertson Fifty Pounds Current Money of Virginia to Her
and Her Heirs for ever

All the Remaining part of my Estate whatever that I have
not given away already, I give and devise to my Daughter
Elizabeth Thruston to her and her Heirs for ever

And Lastly, I hereby Nominate and Appoint my Son John Thruston
and my Daughter Elizabeth Thruston Executor and Executrix
of this my Last will and Testament In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and Seal This Twenty Fifth
Day of September One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty One
