Children of my son John Britt all my stock of cattle to
be equally divided amongst them; I give and bequeath unto
my gran Daughter Mary Britt one Negro Boy called Law-
rence. I give and bequeath unto my gran Daughter Elizabeth
Britt one Negro girl called Bridgett. Item I give unto my
gran Daughter Affelia Britt one Negro Boy called Bobb
farther it is my will that my Negro Boy Tobett be sold to pay
all debts that I justly owe. Item I give unto my Daughter
Affiah Stephens one quart silver Tankard, farther it is
my Will that Mingo and Dublin be hired out to the best
advantage for the Term of seven years for the most

Testament I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Hannah

Amy and Ester and farther I give unto my Daugh^r Hannah

my Daughter Hannah Britt, and the Children of my son
John Britt deed and at the expiration of seven years

Will in Case the Negro Boy shall be sold for more than what I have
the overplus I give unto my Daughter Hannah also and
larger on both, farther it is my Will that whatever of my Estate
that is not mentioned above be sold and divided between my
son John Britts Whitman except the Child I give unto my
Daughter Hannah, Lastly I do nominate & appoint Maj. Rob^t
Fisher M^r Archibald Taylor Chap^l John Shipp or so many of them
as will please to accept the office to be Executors of this my last
Will and Testament at Witness my hand this 5th day of May 1746
