Item I give and bequeath unto my four Daughters, that is to say Eliza Drury, Ann M. Cull, Mary Matthias and Hannah Matthias my Negro Woman Pegg also one Desk, one Safe and one Sett of Tea Ware, to be equally divided amongst them my said Daughters and their Heirs forever —

Item I give unto my Son John Matthias one Case and Bottles to him & his heirs forever —

Item I give unto my Daughter Ann M. Cull one feather Bed, being the Bed she is already possessed with to her and her heirs forever —
