buried in Decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors:

Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the Same
Again by the mighty power of God. and As touching such worldly estate
Wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give demise and
dispose of the Same in the following manner and form —

I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved Mother Ann Manning my Negro
Wench Lettice with her three Children William James and John
for her Natural Life time at her death I give the Negro boy William to
John Manning Son of my Brother John Manning and his heirs forever
My Negro Boy James I give to Reuben Harper Son of David Harper^{dec'd} and his
heirs for ever My Negro boy John I give to my sister Margaret Hatten and

Her heirs for ever the Negro wench Lettice at my Mother's decease with what Increase she
may have besides the above mentioned three Children to be equally divided between my brothers
Malcolm Manning John and Reuben Manning my sister Mary Harper and Margaret Hatten
Also I constitute make ordain my brother in law Francis Hatten sole Executor to this
My last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 28th day of July 1791
