Daughters Mary Nash and Frances Ann Etheridge
and their Heirs for ever —

And for the true Performance of every thing contained in this
my last Will and Testament, I appoint my Son Samuel Portlock
my Executor in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand and fixt my Seal this Eleventh day of July in the year
of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and sixty nine. —
