Item I do Constitute and Appoint my worthy friend John Rensberg resident
in the Borough of Norfolk in the Province and Dominion of Virginia
aforesaid and no other person by whatsoever means my whole and
Sole heir to all money and monies that have shall or may come to me
out of the arrears due in Donaghedy Parish in the County of Tyrone
in Ireland Amounting to upwards of Two Thousand pounds Starting for
the collection of which Mr. Trusty Carey was agent chosen by my
late father The Reverend George Bricegirdle Rector of the above
parish of Donaghedy & since his demise continued in the same
Employ — Item after the death of the said John Rensberg
my Will is that his wife Rebecca shall enjoy the same Estate and
