Item I give and bequeath my Personal Estate to be equally
divided after the Death of my Mother between my Brothers
Josiah Trufs, Samuel Trufs and Thomas Wallace, to them
and their Heirs forever.

Item I constitute and appoint my Brother Josiah Trufs
whole & Sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and affix
my Seal this Eleventh Day of March in the Year of our Lord
One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Eight.
