I have pleased God to make me Steward of the Goods

my sins and Transgressions in the World & here with
in a blessed Resurrection at the last Day my Body
may be committed to the earth the Original
of all Mankind is it to be decently buried in a
Christian Manner at the Discretion of my well beloved
Executors hereafter named and my worldly Estate which
I have pleased God to make me Steward of far beyond
my Deserts my just Dotts being first paid after my de-
ceased I give and bequeath as follows

sold and after my just Dabts being paid that then it to be
divided between my loving wife and my two Sons John
Colley and Edward Colley. I do hereby nominate, appoint
and ordain my loving Son John Colley the whole Sole Ex^r
of this my last Will and Testament and when it shall
please God to call me hence by Death humbly resign
my precious and immortal Soul into his mercifull
hands & Perdition I have hereunto set my hand & seal
this Twenty Sixth day February 1750/51
