then give and bequeath the said Land and Plantation
to my Son Caleb and his Heirs forever

Item All my other Estate of what kind soever (after the de-
cease of my said Wife, I give to be equally divided a-
mong my said Sons James, Caleb, John, Nathan

use of my Land and Plantation, with liberty to cut and sell
any Timber she may think proper, I also leave to my said
loving wife Ann the use of all my other Estate of what
kind soever, during her natural life.

Item I give and bequeath to my Son James and his Heirs forever,
after the decease of my said Wife, the Land and Plantation
whereon I now live, but in case my said Son James should
die without Heirs of his Body lawfully begotten I
then give and bequeath the said Land and Plantation
to my Son Caleb and his Heirs forever.

Item All my other Estate of what kind soever (after the de-
cease of my said Wife, I give to be equally divided a-
mongst my Sons Mason, Hillary, Daniel, John, Nathan
and Caleb, and my Daughter Elizabeth.

Lastly I Nominate and appoint my loving Wife Executrix and
my Son James Executor, to this my last Will and Tes-
